6. Please include your name, grade and contact information on the back of the entry (email, phone number). In the instance of a blackout poem, please ensure that the contact information is attached to the book.
7. Poems submitted via email must have the contact information in the body of the email
8. Entries without contact information are automatically disqualified.
9. We will be unable to return the poems, please keep originals and send in copies.
10. Any poem in a foreign language must have the translation available, judging will be based upon the English translation.
